I would like to take this opportunity to wish our Primary 7 pupils, and all those moving on to new schools, every success and would like to wish all our families a happy and relaxing holiday.

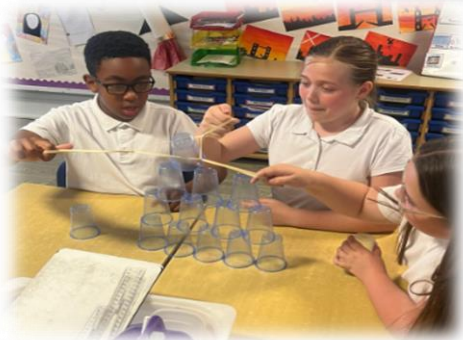
